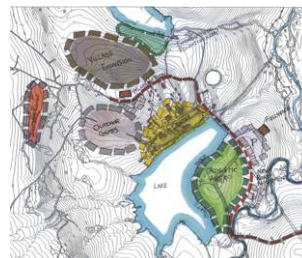
The team's understanding of each site helps drive the design, while taking into account the community that surrounds and supports the project. The team looks to the community to provide input and in-site into the needs of the area.
